




Audio Guide Charger ATC-110

There are 10 charging slots available on this device (shown as photo). More details described as below.

- ① Power switch: Switch to power on; switch to power off.
- ② Function indicator: To identify the device is on charging (indicator lights redly) or shut down (indicator turns off).
- 3 Power input: For power supply DC 12 V / 3.3 A.
- ① Charging indicators (ON): "ON" indicator lights amber when charging.
- ⑤ Fully charged indicators (OK): "OK" indicator lights greenly when fully charged.
- © Charging slots: Locate AT-100 to charge. This device allows 10 pcs of AT-100 to be charged at the same time.







Audio Guide Updater ATC-110U

This device has 10 slots for AT-100 to charge and update (shown as photo), details described as below.

- ① Power switch: Two switches available, one for charging mode and the other for updating mode.
- ② Function indicator: LED indicator lights redly when charging; or it lights greenly when updating.
- 3 Power input: For power supply DC 12 V/3.3 A.
- 4 USB port: To link with a laptop or computer to implement update.
- ⑤ Charging indicators (ON): "ON" indicator lights amber when charging.
- © Fully charged indicators (OK): "OK" indicator lights greenly when fully charged.
- Charging slots: Locate AT-100 to charge or to update. This device allows 10 pcs of AT-100 to be charged or updated at the same time.
- Link indicator: The indicator will light greenly when linking with a laptop or computer correctly.

 Error indicator: The indicator will light redly when linking with a laptop or computer incorrectly.



HOW TO USE

A. Used as a charger: ATC-110 / ATC-110U

- 1. When AT-100 gives a sign of low battery (must be NiMH rechargeable batteries), please allocate it onto ATC-110 or ATC-110U for charging. Steps listed as below.
 - a. Turn the AT-100 off.
 - b. Plug the power supply DC 12 V/3.3 A to power input,
 - c. Turn on the power and switch it to charging mode.
 - d. Allocate AT-100 on any slot and the charging indicator "ON" lights amber.
 - e. The fully charged indicator "OK" will light greenly when it's done



Power input lack.

- 2, AT-100 does not react when in charging, (no LED indicator will light up)
- 3. ATC-110 or ATC-110U allows maximum 10 pcs AT-100 to be charged concurrently.

4. Remarks:


- a. Indicator "ON" lights up when ch dicator "OK" lights up when fully charged.
- b. When indicator "ON" lights and glitters, please make sure batteries are in good condition or batteries are NiMH rechargeable.
- c. ATC-110 or ATC-110U will keep supplying tiny current to AT-100 when it's fully charged (indicator "OK" lights up) but not been removed from charger, to ensure battery energy in AT-100 are full.

- 1. Disposable batteries are NOT allowed to be charged.
- 2. DO NOT mix new battery and old battery to use, in case of any risk of leakage or explosion will arise.
- 3. Please take out batteries when the device won't be used for a long time, to avoid any leakage.

HOW TO USE

B. Used as an updater: ATC-110U

- When files in AT-100 need to be changed, removed, deleted or updated, the Audio Guide Updater ATC-110U will be required.
- 2. Steps to update described as below:
 - a. Turn the AT-100 off.
 - b. Plug power supply 12 V/3.3 A to power input.
 - c. Turn the ATC-110U on and switch it to "update mode".
 - d. Connect ATC-110U with a laptop (or computer) via USB cable.
 - e. Allocate AT-100 onto any slot of ATC-110U. The indicator "LINK" lights greenly when the linkage is successful. The linkage isn't successful when indicator "ERR" lights redly.
 - f. Implement updating program "Audio Guide AT-100 Series" shown on laptop (or computer). Update program required to be installed for use in first time.



CAUTION

- Keep away from heating source; don't put the unit next to any object with high heat or temperature.
- 2. Inappropriate move or squeeze is prohibited.
- DO NOT use rechargeable and general batteries together. DO NOT mix old and new batteries to charge.
- 4. Put the charger or updater on a flat table, or have it mounted on the wall.
- Recommend to use power supply DC 12V / 3.3A that comes along with the device.
- Please take out batteries if the units won't be in use for a longer period in case of any leakage from batteries.

TROUBLESHOOTING

When you meet abnormal problems during updating process to AT-100, please follow instructions below to sort out.

- 1. Turn AT-100 off.
- 2. Put AT-100 onto the slot of updater (ATC-110U).
- 3. Turn ATC-110U on and switch it to "update" mode.
- 4. Format AT-100.
- 5. Remove AT-100 from updater safely.
- 6. Turn AT-100 on and keep it up for 5~6 seconds.
- 7. The AT-100 should be working well now, please try to update again.
- Remind again; make sure to turn AT-100 off before implementing update. It might cause AT-100 contained data failed or damaged if you DO NOT turn it off.
- If you still can not sort out the update problem after trying solution mentioned above, please check if your system was infected by virus.
